Flu shots protect you, your family, and others from the flu. A new flu shot is recommended for everyone, every fall. Flu shots are especially recommended for:

- People 50 years and older
- Pregnant women
- Children 6 months to 18 years
- People with any chronic medical conditions
- Health care workers
- People in long-term health care facilities
- Caregivers of children 6 months and younger or other high risk individuals.

The cost of the flu shot is **\$10.00.**
